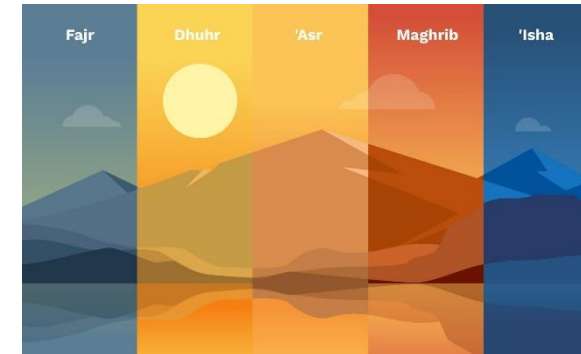


Year 3 – religion, family, community and prayer - RE

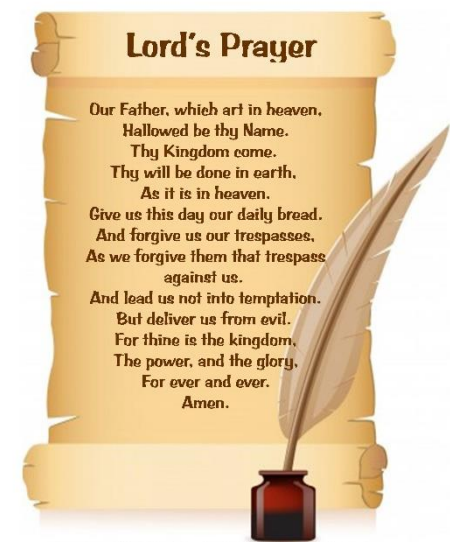


Key Vocabulary	
Qur'an	Holy book of Islam. This book is believed to be written directly by God Through the prophet Muhammad and some Muslims call it the final testament
Mosque	Place of prayer for Muslims or followers of the religion of Islam. Many mosques are large buildings with towers or domes and the inside of a mosque always include an open space for worship. The floor will be covered with rugs or mats
Prophet	Someone speaks on behalf of God
Lords prayer	Prayer of Christianity that Jesus taught his followers. It is an example of how to pray and what to believe as Christians
Allah	It is an Arabic term for God. Muslims use many names to describe God but "Allah" means all of the Gods.
Communal	Something that is shared by all members of a community or religion
Atheist	Someone who does not believe in God.
Humanist	They do not believe in God. They do not follow a traditional religion

The Lord's prayer is a common Christian prayer



Prayer allows Muslims to communicate with Allah. Christians and Muslims can pray anywhere.
