Do to other people what you would like them to do to you

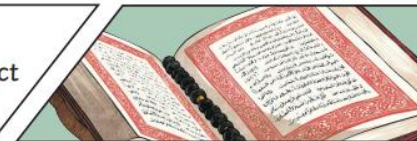


Fauja Singh

The **Muslim** holy book is called **the Qur'an**. **Muslims** believe that it is a record of the exact words that Allah said.



### A Sacred Text
