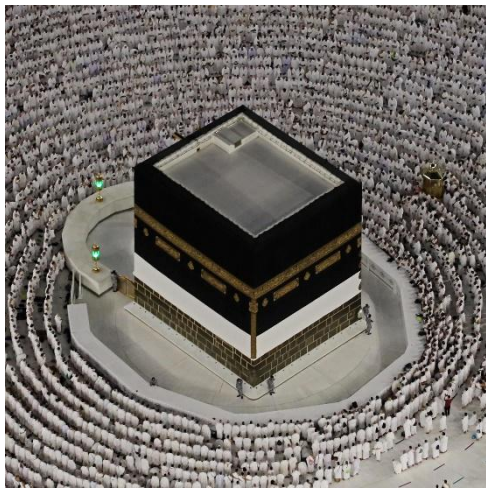


# Year 4 – Pilgrimages



<b>Key Vocabulary</b>	
<b>Pilgrimage</b>	A visit to a place that is considered special, where you go to show your respect
<b>Pilgrim</b>	Person who goes on a pilgrimage
<b>Ritual</b>	A religious ceremony consisting of a series of actions performed according to a prescribed order
<b>Symbol</b>	A religious symbol is an iconic representation intended to represent a specific religion, or a specific concept within a given religion
<b>Community</b>	The condition of sharing or having certain attitudes and interests in common
<b>Commitment</b>	Commitment is a strong belief in an idea or system
<b>Values</b>	Religious values define what people expect of themselves and of others based on the beliefs common to the religions they practice

Some Christians go on a pilgrimage to Lourdes, or Fatima in Portugal.
