Important dates / Enrichment

RE / Music

R.E—> To learn about Judaism and important stories that are studied by Jewish people.

Music—> Music technology, structure and form. Identifying instruments of the orchestra.

P.E : - Tennis—> With the expertise of the local tennis club, we shall be learning the basic skills of tennis and putting these into practise in paired play.

-Athletics—> Children will practise the basic skills needed to compete in basic athletic sporting events. This will help them develop jumping, throwing and running skills.

Geography / History

Geography—> To name and locate cities of the UK. To name and locate seaside's in the UK and recognise features of the seaside.

History—> To know who Grace Darling is and why she is remembered today.

English

This half term we will be looking at a range of Fairy tales. We shall talk about features of this genre as well as thinking about how to alternate a Fairy tale ending or compare it to another story that might be similar.

What you can do at home

Read 4 times a week with your child and record in their diary.

Practise weekly spellings at home and common exception words. The children may want to use the spelling words in simple sentences.

Maths

Fractions—>To recognise fractions and what these can represent in both quantities and shapes.

Length and Height—> The children will be measuring height and length using the correct equipment and vocabulary. They will compare lengths and solve real life problems with length.

Position and direction—> The children will be describing turns and the position of a person in comparison with other objects.

What you can do at home

Practise and know numbers to 100. To know the 2, 5 and 10 timetables by rote.

RHE– Relationships

To know about families, how they are different and how we all have responsibilities and roles in life. To know how our actions affect others.

What you can do at home

Remind your child of how families are different and that each person has their own role within the family. Talk about respect to everyone in a family and how we can be thankful for what our family does.

Art/ DT

ART —> No Art this half term

D&T—> Making mechanisms that pull, turn or flap. Children to practise these mechanisms to incorporate onto a story map.

Computing

To code using Scratch Jr. To plan and create a background with sprite that move independently from each other. This work will be carried out on iPads.

Science

This half term the children will be learning about plants/trees and how they grow. They will also experiment with different types of growing conditions and which ones are better for successful growth.
