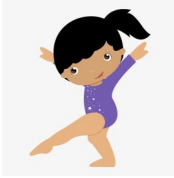

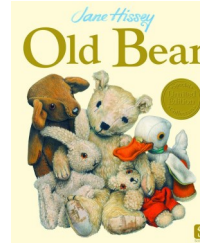

Practise writing numbers to 20 the right way round and formed correctly.

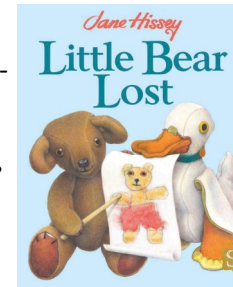
Practise recognising and recalling number bonds to and within 10 (and 20 if they can!)
