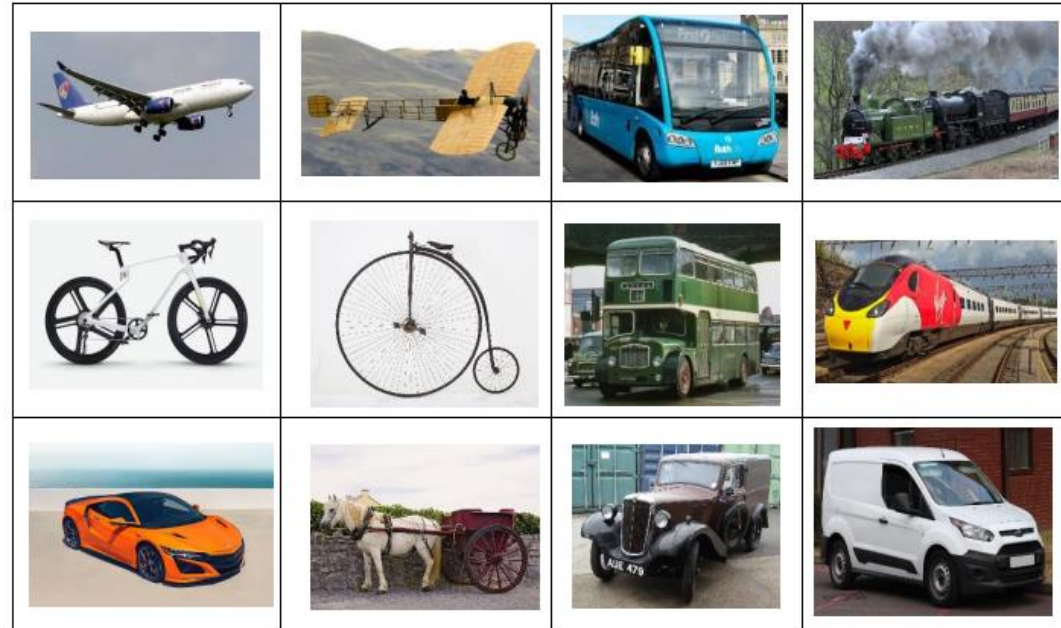


# Travel and Transport- History



## Different types of transport

Key Vocabulary	
<b>Travel</b>	Moving from one place to another.
<b>Transport</b>	Carrying people or goods from one place to another.
<b>Steam Engine</b>	A steam engine uses steam from boiling water to make it move. The steam pushes the moving parts.
<b>Petrol/Combustion Engine</b>	Combustion means burning. A petrol engine burns petrol to make it move.
<b>Electric Cars</b>	Electric cars use electricity to make the motor turn.
<b>Pilot</b>	A person who flies a plane
<b>Vehicles</b>	Used to transport people or goods

Significant People	Date	Information
Amelia Earhart	1897-1937	Amelia was the first woman to cross the Atlantic Ocean in an airplane, this was a huge achievement at that time.
George Stephenson	1781-1848	Inventor of the first steam engine
Henry Ford	1863-1947	Creator of the Ford Model T car and founder of the Ford Motor Company
